### CTC and Kingston to jointly trial new CPD courses

Did you realise that all Cycle Training Providers are required to offer their instructors a minimum of three hours CPD (Continued Professional Development) per annum? To quote the the Bikeability website; “All employees should be part of a programme of Continuing Professional Development (CPD) where they are given the opportunity to improve and broaden their knowledge, skill and personal qualities. This is essential to maintain a high standard of cycle training in line with the National Standard and Bikeability’s overarching aims.”

The CTC has got together with the Royal Borough of Kingston to develop and offer CPD courses to Training Providers and independent Cycling Instructors alike. For the rest of the year these half- day courses will be charged at a subsidised rate of only £30 per instructor.

Course Modules include:

- Moving Groups on the Road
- Road Positioning
- Teaching Techniques
- Alternative Delivery Methods
- Group Management/Risk Management
- Level 1 and 2 refreshers
- Delivering Level 3
