CTC members organise more bike rides than any other cycling organisation anywhere. From Sunday section club runs to large scale national events, they're all there for you to ride. No matter what level of cycling you enjoy, you'll have no trouble finding events to suit your abilities and preferences. The vast majority are organised by CTC's local groups on a voluntary basis.

Whether you look for an event in Cycle or via the 'event search tool' on the CTC website, you should find all the information you need. It's always a good idea to contact the organiser to check if it's okay just to turn up on the day. If it's a more organised type of event, you may need to enter up to a couple of weeks prior to the event. Some local rides will be listed only by your CTC local group, so if you can't find an event near vou here, do check vour local group's website - or phone the secretary, who will be happy to help.
